Position: Environmental Health Inspector

The Logan County Department of Public Health is accepting applications for an immediate opening in the environmental division as an Environmental Health Inspector. Under supervision of the Environmental Health Supervisor, the candidate will receive training and perform semi-technical duties in the field of environmental health. Responsibilities include, food establishment, septic, well and other environmental health related inspections to determine compliance with applicable laws. The ideal candidate will have an Associate's Degree from an accredited college or university, or its equivalent, which includes coursework consisting of a minimum of 9 credit hours of basic sciences in accordance with the Environmental Health Practitioner Licensing Act. Proficiency in MS Word and Excel software is essential. The candidate must also be able to work independently and communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
