The Council is also available to offer support in helping partners to organize, conduct outreach activities and assist with implementation of initiatives.

Action Item #3: The Council discussed a new council Chair as Alison Rumler-Gomez has other challenging time commitments and expressed concern she would not be able to devote the time needed for the position. Nobody on the committee was nominated to replace her. Alison retracted her withdrawal from the Chair position after the Council discussed its role and purpose, so it was agreed she will remain to serve as the Chair of the LCMHAC.
