Position: Environmental Health Intern/Mosquito-Surveillance Representative

The Logan County Department of Public Health is accepting applications for a summer, temporary, 12-week position in the Environmental Health division as an Environmental Health Intern/Mosquito-Surveillance Representative. The position is made available through a grant from the Illinois Department of Public Health. Candidates must be available to work full-time from May 22nd through August 11th.

Responsibilities include (but are not limited to) surveillance, trapping, and testing of mosquitoes for West Nile Virus, tracking and submitting of bird specimens to the state laboratory, larvicide application, and mosquito-borne disease prevention education to the public. Preferred candidates are college graduates or students working toward a degree in biology, environmental health or a related area. This is an entry-level position and training/certification will be provided. Proficiency in MS Word and Excel software is essential. The candidate must also be able to communicate effectively both orally and in writing.

Candidates must be dependable, enthusiastic and have a valid driver's license and reliable transportation. The salary is \$14.00/hr. Applications will be accepted through March 20th.
